Mural Theme: "Equal Pay"

Working with a local female artist, the mural will artistically depict the struggle & triumph of our state's gender wage gap.

Louisiana has no Equal Pay Act, no law on the books to require that men and women be paid equally for equal work. And they are not. For every dollar a man makes, a white woman makes **\$0.69**, while an African American woman makes **\$0.48** and a Latina makes **\$0.52**.

In Baton Rouge **80%** of births are to single mothers
